2006年にWHOハンセン病制圧大使、日本財団会長の笹川陽平によって始められたこの取り組みは、毎年1月の世界ハンセン病の日にあわせ、異なる分野の影響力のある個人や組織からの賛同を得て、ハンセン病差別撤廃のメッセージを発信してきました。第16回目となるグローバル・アピール2021は、2021年1月31日にオンラインで発表されました。

First launched in 2006 by Yohei Sasakawa, WHO Goodwill Ambassador for Leprosy Elimination and chairman of The Nippon Foundation, it is issued every January to coincide with World Leprosy Day, and endorsed each year by world leaders and organizations in different fields.

Launched online on January 31, 2021, Global Appeal in its 16th year is endorsed by the International Trade Union Confederation. gasasakawa.org
